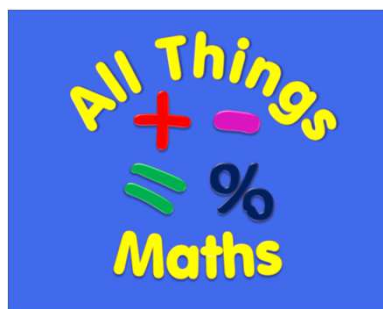
Thank you for downloading this resource.
